Our goal is to further improve our service by consolidating our national status and to achieve enough international position to feed the consumption needs of our customers.

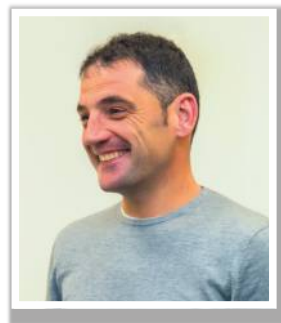

It was 1988 when Joaquim M^a Sindreu, founder of Recymet Systems, had his first contact with the recycling industry.

A few years later, when the economic crisis broke out in 1992, he teamed up with Modesto Freijedo, with whom he developed the commercial action that gave rise to the embryo of Recymet Systems, which was called Sindreu Ltda.

In 1996, Sindreu and Freijedo bought a small industrial building in symbiosis with Joan Casals, head of the oldest company in Catalonia in the metal recovery sector, with whom they acquired a neighbouring building next to the new Recymet Systems.

At present, between the business units in Rubí (Barcelona) and Amorebieta (Vizcaya) and warehouse in Seville, the company has more than 25,800 m² of warehouse space, as well as a representative office in Madrid and sales offices in Italy, Germany and China, from where purchases and sales are made nationally and internationally, with plans for other countries in Europe, Asia, Latin America, as well as the USA.

Recymet enjoys very good financial health managing and commercialising stainless steels, metals and special alloys of all kinds. Alloys based on nickel, titanium, tungsten, tin or zinc. Most of them have their origin in the aeronautics, automotive, oil-gas and subsidiary companies of these sectors. These are materials that offer added value, but require specific know-how compared to regular metals or alloys.

In addition, Recymet guarantees the quality of the materials it supplies to its customers, both in terms of composition and metallic performance in the melting process, which is necessary and of great interest to foundries and steel makers that consume these recycled products.

Recymet has built up the loyalty of many of its suppliers, who often supply materials with the confidence and certainty that they will get the best price proposition. This is because Recymet works in an honest and efficient way, something that our suppliers and collaborators have been able to see throughout the history that unites us.

At the facilities, we carry out a very exhaustive control of the classification and quality of all the material, which is clearly coded thanks to a powerful computer system adapted to our activity. This allows us to identify the quantity available in stock at any given moment, the materials that are about to arrive, as well as the exact location of all the batches that we have stored on the premises.



Thanks to the experience accumulated by our human team, Recymet has defined a map of operational processes, controlled and analysed for a continuous improvement in the quality of the management of its activities.

Recymet's processes begin with the identification and initial recovery of waste at source. It is then removed by means of the appropriate transport and arrives at the facilities where it is classified and analysed to determine the quality and final value of the material.

In accordance with customer requirements, the materials are prepared and packaged and finally delivered to the customer for final consumption as a substitute for raw materials from mining and natural resources.

Materials

Recymet Systems specialises in the following groups of materials:

- **Common or special stainless steels and refractory stainless steels.**
- **High speed steels, tool steels and tool steels**
- **Nickel and Iron based special alloys and superalloys**
- **Aeronautical aluminium**
- **Special base alloys Copper**
- **Tin, Lead and their alloys**
- **Magnesium and its alloys**
- **Titanium and its alloys**
- **Cobalt and its alloys**
- **Tungsten carbide and tungsten alloys**
- **Zinc and its alloys**



Recymet, aware of the importance of quality in the management of its activities and respect for the environment, has defined a number of principles that are a reference framework for present and future environmental goals and quality objectives:

- Strictly comply with all legal requirements applicable to its activity, as well as those related to environmental aspects.
- Maintain good relations with the business environment. For this reason, and despite being located in an industrial environment, we are careful to avoid any nuisance caused by the processes, maintaining the highest standards in terms of hygiene and order.
- Working to continually improve the equipment and to achieve higher percentages of recycled material.
- Internal reviews by Management at planned intervals to ensure the adequacy and continuous improvement of its Integrated Management System. This integrated policy is communicated to all people working and/or collaborating with our organisation.
- Know and achieve the satisfaction of customers and suppliers, attending to their needs, expectations and requirements before and after delivery.

Recymet is endorsed by the BIR (Bureau International of Recycling), the FER (Federación Española del Reciclaje) and the Gremi de Recuperació de Catalunya. It is also authorised by public bodies such as the Catalan Waste Agency, the Department of the Environment of the Basque Government and the Department of the Environment of the Regional Government of Andalusia.

It has ISO 9001 Quality Management Systems, ISO 14001 Environmental Management Systems and ISO 45.001 Occupational Health and Safety Systems approvals.

Recymet Systems also has the EU 333/2015 and EU 715/2015 certifications, thanks to its compliance with the requirements of article 6 of the European Union Council Regulation. This establishes the criteria for certain types of metallic waste, metals and alloys of Aluminium, Steel and Copper to cease to be considered waste by virtue of the European Parliament and Directive 2008/98/EC. This allows Recymet to legally deliver a high percentage of the products as real raw material substitutes and not as waste or scrap.
